STUDENT VISA INTERVIEW

Now that you've been admitted, we want to ensure you arrive at your student visa interview with all required documentation. Visit admissions.rutgers.edu/visa and follow the steps to prepare for your scheduled appointment.

January

- **Submit the required documents for your I-20** *January–June*
 - To receive your I-20, you must accept our offer of admission and submit the necessary financial documents (dated on or later than January 1, 2021).
- **On-campus Housing and/or Dining**
 - You will begin receiving information about the application process for on-campus housing and dining. Keep an eye out!

February

- **Register for International Student Orientation** *February–August*
 - International Student Orientation helps incoming international students adjust to life in the United States and at Rutgers. You will have an opportunity to learn about resources available to you as a Rutgers student, hear tips and strategies to best navigate the campus, and connect with other new students and student leaders. Register at my.rutgers.edu.

March

- **Look for scholarship notification** *early March–May*
 - Scholarship recipients will receive information regarding their scholarship in their financial aid offer letter made available by the Office of Financial Aid in early March. Visit admissions.rutgers.edu/scholarships for more information.
- **Complete placement tests** *starting March 1 (within 30 days of enrollment)*
 - Placement testing for math, English, and most world languages is conducted online. Activate your NetID and access the tests at my.rutgers.edu under *Required for Enrollment*. If you enroll prior to April, you should complete all tests by April 30; otherwise, please complete tests within 30 days of enrolling. Students awaiting accommodations are not subject to these timelines.
- **Choose a tuition payment plan (optional)** *March–June*
 - Rutgers offers several tuition payment plans that allow you to pay your term bill charges over time in convenient monthly installments. For more information, visit studentabc.rutgers.edu/tuition-payment-plans.
- **Obtain your I-20, pay your SEVIS I-901 fee, and apply for a visa** *March–July*
 - After receiving your I-20 from Rutgers, pay your SEVIS I-901 fee at fmjfee.com and apply for your visa at a U.S. embassy or consulate. The fee may be waived for current visa holders. Visit ice.gov/sevis/i901/faq for more information.

April

- **Attend Virtual Open House** *April 10*
 - Get instant access to the world of Rutgers–New Brunswick right at your fingertips. Stream videos, connect with staff LIVE, get an exclusive look at life as a Scarlet Knight from current students, and more! Visit [RutgersOnDemand.com](https://www.rutgers.edu/on-demand).
- **Attend an academic advising program** *April–August*
 - Meet with advisers and plan your fall course schedule. Find more information at my.rutgers.edu.

May

- **Accept our offer of admission** *by May 1*
 - Accept our offer of admission at admissions.rutgers.edu/accept. After May 1, we cannot guarantee your space will remain available. Students admitted after April 24 have one week to accept our offer of admission.
- **Receive your credit evaluation** *May–August (transfer students only)*
 - All transfer students who've accepted our offer of admission will receive a credit evaluation by the appropriate academic dean's office. New Jersey county college students should visit njtransfer.org to view the transferability of courses.

June

- **Submit your final official record(s)** *by June 1 (transfer students only)*
 - Your final record(s) must include certification of any diplomas or degrees and final grades for courses in progress at the time of your admission. These documents must be mailed in a sealed envelope to: Undergraduate Admissions Operations Center, 65 Davidson Road, Room 202, Piscataway, New Jersey, 08854-8097.
- **Prepare for arrival in the U.S.** *June–August*
 - For information to assist you in preparing for your arrival, visit ice.gov/sevis/students. F-1 visa holders currently studying in the U.S. should work with their school adviser to have their SEVIS record transferred to Rutgers.

July

- **Submit your final official record(s)** *by July 1 (first-year students only)*
 - Your final record(s) must include certification of any diplomas or degrees and final grades for courses in progress at the time of your admission. These documents must be mailed in a sealed envelope to: Undergraduate Admissions Operations Center, 65 Davidson Road, Room 202, Piscataway, New Jersey, 08854-8097.
- **View your term bill** *mid-July*
 - Term bills are available at studentabc.rutgers.edu beginning mid-July. Payment due dates begin in August. See payment plan options at studentabc.rutgers.edu/tuition-payment-plans.

August

- **Submit your immunization record** *by August 1*
 - Your immunization record must be signed by your health care provider. Download the immunization form at admissions.rutgers.edu/immunization.
- **Pay your term bill** at studentabc.rutgers.edu *due date will be displayed on your bill*

September

- **Fall semester begins** *September 1*
